API Documentation

`zweig.walk_preorder` (*tree*)

Yields the nodes in the *tree* in preorder.

`zweig.to_source` (*tree*)

Returns the Python source code representation of the *tree*.

`zweig.dump` (*node*, *annotate_fields=True*, *include_attributes=False*)

Like `ast.dump()` but with a more readable return value, making the output actually useful for debugging purposes.

`zweig.is_possible_target` (*node*)

Returns *True*, if the *node* could be a target for example in an assignment statement ignoring the expression contexts.

`zweig.set_target_contexts` (*node*)

Given a node that could be a target, sets the *.ctx* attribute to `ast.Store` instances as appropriate.
